## Acceptable Bottoms

Navy blue, Black or Khaki pants, shorts, jumpers, skirts or shorts

- ☐ Jumpers, skirts, shorts must be respectable and modest in length, no more than 2"-3" above the knee
- ☐ Clothing items must be worn at the natural waistline and fit properly, not overly tight or baggy
- ☐ Lounge wear or pajamas are not permitted
- ☐ Jeans, cargo pants/shorts, carpenter/painter, corduroy, yoga pants, spandex/leggings, pajama bottoms, sweatpants, etc..are not permitted
- ☐ Tights/leggings may be worn under skirts and jumpers but must be solid black or navy blue
- ☐ Jeans will be permitted on days designated by Administration

## Acceptable Tops

- ☐ Any solid color, collared polo style shirt
- ☐ Logos or brand names must be smaller than a half dollar
- ☐ All shirts must fit properly
- ☐ Sunshine Shirts will be permitted on days as designated by Administration
- ☐ Outerwear jackets are acceptable for cool Days. No Hoodies.



## Acceptable Shoes

- ☐ Shoes must be athletic type or dress shoes with closed toes and back and must be properly fastened
- ☐ Sandals, flip-flops, any open toed shoe, Crocs, high heels, and wheeled shoes are not permitted
- ☐ Tennis shoes must be worn on P.E. days
- ☐ Please check your child's Enrichment Schedule so you are aware of what days of the week this occurs

## Hair/Jewelry/Make Up

- ☐ No dangling earrings or excessive jewelry that could likely cause injury or distractions such as; chokers, dog collars, spikes, etc. are not permitted
- ☐ Tattoos of any kind, permanent or temporary are not permitted as well as body stickers
- ☐ Sweatbands, bandanas are not permitted
- ☐ Hair/hair extension color is limited to any naturally occurring color and hair dye of any type is not permitted
- ☐ Extreme distracting hair styles and haircuts such as; mohawks, edging, extreme spiked hair, or designs cut into hair may be considered a distraction and therefore are not permitted
- ☐ Hats are not permitted unless worn for P.E. or on Spirit Days designated by Administration
